**EXTRA-FINANCIAL RATING**

**LA POSTE GROUPE JOINS THE VERY SELECT CIRCLE OF COMPANIES LISTED A BY THE CDP (EX CARBON DISCLOSURE PROJECT)**

**La Poste Groupe and the La Banque Postale conglomerate have been placed on the Corporate A List by the CDP. This rating confirms the social commitment of La Poste Groupe and its banking, insurance and asset management subsidiaries in the fight against climate change. This rating completes the group's track record, which saw an improvement in its Ecovadis rating (+2 points with a score of 79/100 and a gold medal) in September 2024; then in its Moody's ESG Assessment rating (+4 points with a score of 81/100, positioning it on the world's top step, all sectors combined) in November 2024.**

Evaluated by CDP on its environmental reporting performance, La Poste Groupe has once again been awarded an A rating, with nearly 400 of the more than 24,000 companies worldwide assessed on their environmental reporting transparency (i.e. less than 2% of the companies assessed worldwide by CDP). In Europe, fewer than 5 companies in the transport and logistics sector are on the A list.

This distinction highlights the stringency of the Group's strategy, and the initiatives it has taken to strengthen its robustness:

- inventory and full integration of scope 3 for the measurement of GHG emissions, with a coverage rate of 25% for La Banque Postale's category 15,
- carbon trajectories to 2030 and 2040 certified by SBTi for the Group perimeter,
- the implementation and roll-out of a carbon budget in all Group branches, in order to manage the reduction of emissions in line with the carbon trajectory and the rigorous management of associated resources, costs and investments
- updating of climate risk mapping in line with TCFD principles and for the Group as a whole
- publication as an "early adopter" of the first Climate & Nature report on La Banque Postale's banking activities, in line with the TCFD-TNFD recommendations, and calculation of a biodiversity footprint for 39% of the bank's balance sheet.

This work testifies to the Group's commitments and its desire for transparency in the policies it implements.

In 2024, La Poste Groupe reduced its GHG emissions by more than 5% and continued to record a reduction in its GHG emissions per parcel, at both Colissimo and Geopost. Over the past 10 years, Colissimo has reduced its CO2 emissions per parcel by more than 50%.

In addition to its mitigation efforts, the Group has an active policy of protecting biodiversity and adapting to climate change, notably by financing 54 CO2 emission reduction and carbon sequestration programs across France, 30 of which are certified the Low Carbon Label.



**This new rating encourages the Group to pursue its transformation to develop a sustainable, profitable and responsible business model, by developing business activities with a strong societal benefit while working for fair transitions.**

#### **About La Poste Groupe**

La Poste is a state-owned public limited company, a subsidiary of Caisse des Dépôts and the French State. La Poste Groupe is divided into four business units: Services-Mail-Parcels, Retail Customers and Digital Services, Geopost and La Banque Postale, which, with its subsidiary CNP Assurances, is the 11<sup>th</sup> largest banking and insurance company in the Euro area. La Poste Groupe carries out four public service missions that shape its identity: universal postal service, regional development, banking accessibility, and press transport and delivery. Committed to its regional coverage, La Poste Groupe relies on its network of local, human and digital services, the largest in France. This network consists of 37,300 service points including 17,700 contact points (post offices, local postal agencies, retail pickup points) and nearly 19,600 access points to postal services (Pickup retail relays and lockers, business centers). La Poste Groupe delivers more than 15 billion items a year worldwide (letters, printed advertising media and parcels), six days a week. In 2023, La Poste Groupe generated a turnover of €34.1 billion (44% outside France) and had a headcount of 233,000, in more than 60 countries over 5 continents, of which 179,000 in France. Through its strategic plan "La Poste 2030, committed for you", the company is setting the course for profitable and responsible growth in France and internationally based on a robust multi-activity model. As a mission-driven company since June 2021 and a leader in ecological transition and sustainable finance, La Poste Groupe aims to achieve "Zero Net Emissions" by 2040.
